Prohibition Summer restriction from 1 June to 15 September

• on Sunday: from 14h00 to 20h00

Exceptions: 4 and 11 September, no driving restrictions.

ADDITIONAL SUMMER RESTRICTION

Vehicles concerned all vehicles of over 20t total laden weight

Prohibition during the summer period, from 13h00 to 21h00 when temperature exceeds 35°C

MAIN RESTRICTIONS IN SOFIA

Vehicles concerned trucks and combined vehicles of 4t MPW and above

Prohibition every day, from 7h00 to 21h00.

Area concerned Sofia City centre
